

DECISION
ABOUT THE 2022 WINNERS
OF THE HUNGARIAN–POLISH NON-GOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION PROGRAMME

Based on the *Memorandum of Understanding* creating a *Non-governmental Cooperation Programme* signed by HE János Martonyi, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Hungary and Mr Piotr Serafin, Secretary of State of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland on 29th January 2014, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Hungary and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland have jointly launched a *Call for Applications* on the 21st of February 2022. The aim of the call was supporting non-governmental projects, originated from the two countries.

Based upon the decision of the Signatory Parties, the list of projects receiving funding from the Programme are decided by a Committee that consist of members from the Hungarian diplomatic corps based in Poland and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland. In 2022, after the careful reviewing of all 30 applications, based on the principles of the *Memorandum of Understanding*, the Committee has selected the following projects for funding:
